**Please Note:**

- Field events run continuously all day. Running events take precedence. Please make arrangements with field event coordinators if you need to leave an event to compete in a running event.
- High Jump takes precedence over other field events. Please make arrangements with field event coordinators if you need to leave an event to compete in a High Jump event.
- High Jump: Each competitor may have three attempts at each height. The first rise will be 3cm, then another 3cm, and then continue with rises of 1cm or at the discretion of the official-in-charge. Flat markers only shall be used for start points.
- Long Jump: Each competitor shall have three jumps. Each jump will be measured.
- Shot Put & Discus: All first throws will be marked with pins. The standard will then be set at 6th place distance for the remaining throws. Only throws further than the set standard will be measured.
- The 1500m, 800m and 200m events are outright finals.
- 'Christmas Tree' and 'Pyramid' spikes may be worn in the 100m, 200m, Long Jump, High Jump and Relay events. Spikes must be carried to and from the event. They must be removed at the conclusion of an event and not worn in the spectator areas.
- In the case of inclement weather, causing the carnival to be called off, heats completed will be used as timed finals for Western qualification. Students are encouraged to run their best at all times.
- Certificates and champion trophies will be given to schools after the carnival.
- Toilets are located next to the Club House.
- Please keep the grounds clean and tidy.
- Any disputes must be reported to your own School Team Manager. If the team manager believes the dispute is warranted, then they must place this dispute in writing and present it to the recording table within 15 minutes of the event concluding. No parents are to approach the officials or recording table with the intention of complaining or questioning results. Officials have the right to ask parents to return to school areas.

**Selecting a District Team**

- The District Team will include children placing 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, or 3<sup>rd</sup> in each event.
- Only the 1<sup>st</sup> place getter of the 1500m event will qualify for the Western Trials.
- Only 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> place getters of the 800m event will qualify for the Western Trials.
- Competitors in Field Events MUST make Western Qualifying distances and heights. If a competitor does not make qualifying distances/heights, they will not be invited to participate at the Western Trials, regardless of their placing at the District Carnival.

**Coaching:**

Parents, coaches and unauthorised persons are not allowed on the track, at the finishing line or on the fields. Once competitors are in the hands of the officials controlling the event, they shall not receive any coaching or advice. If this is not adhered to, the officials have the authority to ask the adult who is coaching to leave the area. Penalty for breaching this rule is disqualification of the competitor involved.

Due to safety regulations spectators must remain in the areas designated for non-competitors.

**The carnival manager reserves the right to:**

- Vary the program of events on the day if required.
- Disallow the selection of a student due to poor sportsmanship or behaviour.

Please note which events are heats and which events are finals. Children should be encouraged to perform at their peak capacity in all of their events.

There will not be official recess or lunch breaks for students today. Please make sure that children eat and hydrate at times that are suitable to them.

Please ensure students are being sun safe at our carnival. Remember to reapply your sunscreen and wear a hat when not competing.
