Reptile Visit

On Monday students attended an amazing reptile workshop in our old school building. Dave brought along some of his cold-blooded and eight-legged friends to teach our students about reptiles, spiders, snake safety and first-aid. It is the perfect time of year to raise awareness of snakes and what to do if you come across one. Please quiz your children about this as well as what the first-aid response should be. Some bandage practice could be handy!
