### Remembrance Day

### What to expect if COVID comes to school

You will have seen in the media that there are regularly schools throughout NSW that are affected with COVID cases. In the event that there is a COVID case at our school, the situation is managed externally and we assist in that process. There will be general communication through Schoolstream. There will be a contact tracing process and affected families will be contacted by email or seesaw if their student has been a close contact. Close contacts will need to isolate for a period (up to two weeks) and follow testing procedures before returning to school. It is likely that the whole class of an effected student or teacher will be classified as a close contact. At no stage will individuals be identified publicly.

### Kindergarten Orientation

Once again our new Kindergarten students have shown confidence, maturity and resilience in coming along for their orientation mornings. Thank you Ms Lane for introducing our new Kindergarten students to Canobolas. Looking forward to having you guys here every day next year!

### Parking at school

Our system of dropping-off and picking-up students keeps them safe and many parents appreciate that it is efficient. We ask that you don't park across the road at either time because it means crossing through the traffic that is moving. If you need to park, please do so in Wright's Lane. We are on a dangerous corner that sees a lot of through-traffic including semi-trailers, as well as our own cars. Thanks for your cooperation.

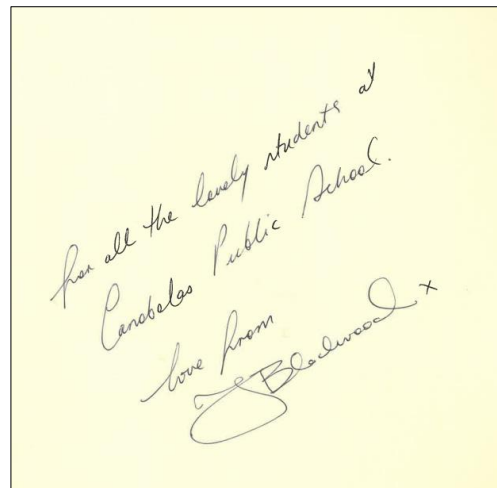
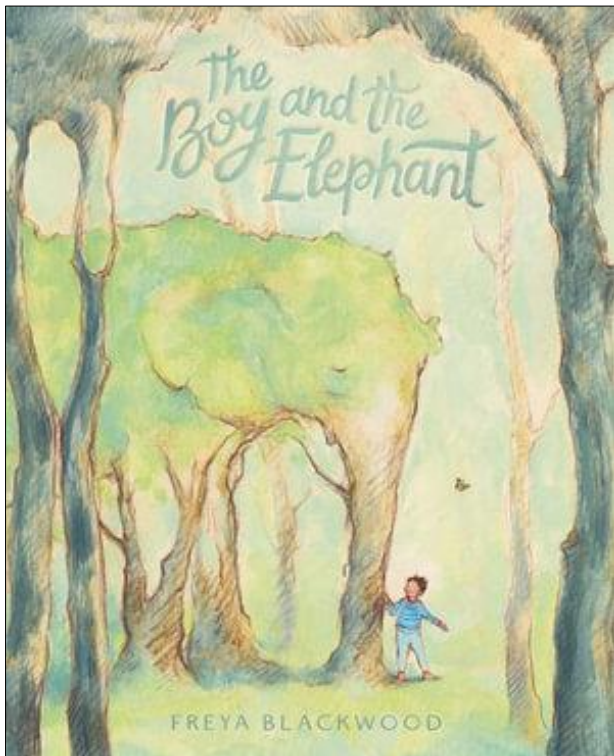
